Charge and Goals:

Charge:	Develop and put into action an interagency plan that establishes the movement of transitioning youth with ASD into adult life of choice by developing individualized supports and services that maximize opportunities for participation in lifelong learning, employment experiences and community participation.
Goals:	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Identify best practices in transition programming for youth with ASD.2. Identify the opportunities and strategies to enhance effectiveness through collaboration between K-12 education and adult services, employment and continuing education.3. Create an interagency plan that identifies the barriers and aligns solutions for a successful coordinated transition of youth with ASD from the K-12 educational settings to adult services, employment and education.4. Develop practical standards for collaboration with providers of services for transition age youth with ASD.5. Increase the awareness of transition processes and opportunities for youth with ASD by professionals, families, and youth.6. Identify strategies to measure progress over time.
